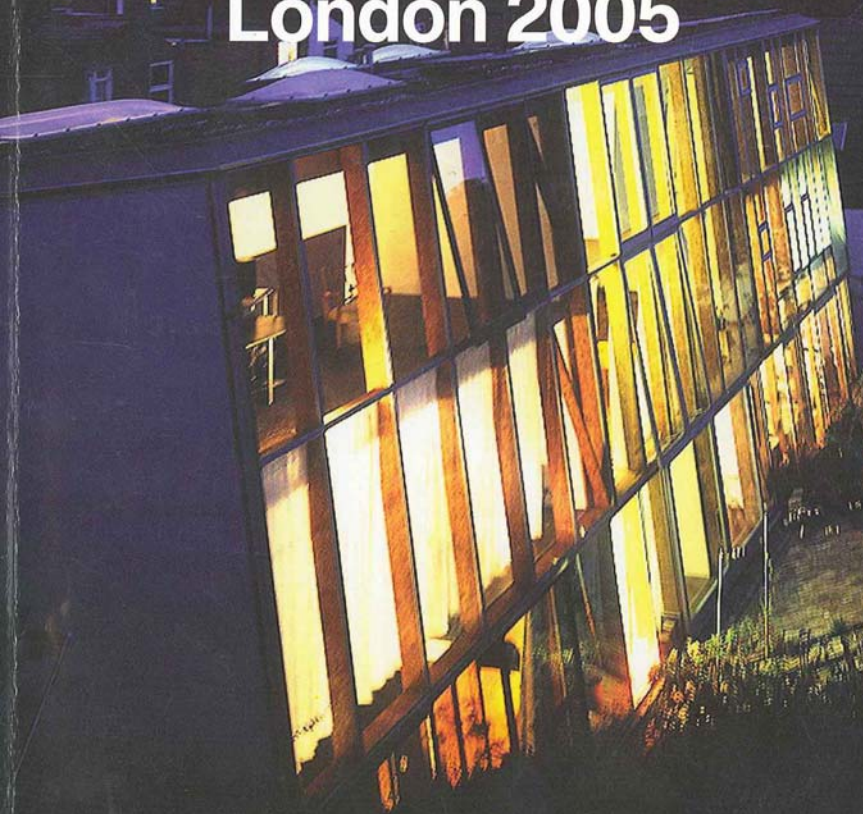

Glass is extensively used to enhance the interior space, including skylights, glass blocks, glass blocks and frosted glass portholes.

The brief was to convert three two-storey mews buildings, previously used as offices, into three mews houses for commercial rental. The buildings were internally gutted and three storeys inserted within the two-storey envelope, making use of an internal atrium at the rear to bring in light where windows don't exist, and give a sense of space and volume. The design makes creative use of space to achieve three bedrooms, two bathrooms, a combined living/dining/kitchen and internal garage.
